

What is BIRST?

Brain Injury Rehabilitative Support Team

Interdisciplinary team with a Clinical focus on Brain Injuries

- **Primary Goal:** To provide wrap around services focusing on improving motor, social, and cognitive skills to enhance the capacity of the individual to achieve independent living.
- Mission: To improve the quality of life for individuals impacted by Brain Injury, Serious Mental Illness and other Neuro-Cognitive Disorders.

BIRST Home


- Community Partner Home
- Provides appropriate stepdown services for individuals discharging from State Facilities
- Supports clients in a home setting, by providing behavioral health expertise to include hands on services and interactions

Psychosocial Rehabilitation Program (Day Treatment)

- Open to the community
- Provides specialized Brain Injury Therapeutic Treatment

Specialized Psychoeducational, Clinical, and Supportive Services

- Person Centered Care
- Outpatient Therapy
- Case Management
- Vocational Rehabilitation
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation
- Mental Health Skill Building
- Occupational Therapy
- Physical Therapy

Eligibility Criteria

- Be a resident of Region 5
- Eighteen (18) years of age of older
- Diagnosis
 - Home Has a diagnosis of BI with a dual diagnosis of SMI
 - Community Has a diagnosis of PTSD or BI with dual diagnosis of SMI

Region V Gero Community Stabilization Team

Overview

- Partnership between DBHDS and WTCSB
- Community-based interdisciplinary care team that supports individuals diagnosed with neurocognitive disorders such as Dementia, Alzheimer's, Parkinson's Disease, or a Serious Mental Illness (SMI) to prevent hospitalization/incarceration
- Services Provided:
 - Person Centered Care
 - Case Management
 - Outpatient therapy
 - Behavior Management
 - Medical Management
 - Regional Training

Referrals

Criteria

- 65 years or older
- Diagnosis of Dementia and/or SMI
- History of psychiatric hospitalization, be at risk of psychiatric hospitalization or at risk of incarceration.
- Resident of Region 5 Area





"The Village" Memory Care Unit at Tidewater Cove

- Partnership between the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services and Tidewater Cove
- 8 beds and 2 respite beds are dedicated to the memory care unit.
- Goal for this new unit is to continue hospitalization prevention work by providing care for patients with dementia
- Supports include:
 - Case Management
 - Medical
 - Psychiatric
 - Social
 - On-site activities
